CAFÉS

Hidden beneath Vyšehrad Castle, this Cuban café is a tropical escape in Prague. With Latin music, warm hospitality, and sweet rum drinks, it’s perfect for a relaxed mid-morning or evening break.

A hybrid café and stationery boutique, this Letná hideaway combines excellent coffee with creative inspiration. A haven for journaling, sketching, or simply soaking up its artsy, welcoming vibe.

Set in a dreamy, shabby-chic space near Letenské Square, this boho café offers espresso, lemonades, and light bites with vintage decor and a relaxed local crowd.

QUICK BITES

Grab a tray and join locals for home-style guláš, svíčková, and more at this self-service spot. No frills, cheap prices, and an authentic lunch experience. (Cash only)

Step back in time at this retro cafeteria tucked in the Světozor Passage. It’s a nostalgic lunch stop with classic Czech comfort food and a touch of Communist-era charm.

This stylish bistro reinvents the Czech chlebiček with toppings like smoked salmon or beet and goat cheese. A light, creative, and affordable snack between sights.

A butcher shop meets bistro, known for juicy burgers and meatloaf served straight from the counter. Popular with locals for a quick, top-quality bite. Expect to stand and eat.

Cult-favorite Vietnamese joint offering bold flavors at budget prices. Nothing fancy—just big bowls of pho, grilled pork noodles, and lines of loyal locals at lunch.

CASUAL FINE DINING

A Czech gastropub with a Michelin nod. Great for date nights, with Moravian wines and a cozy vibe just off the tourist path. Reserve ahead.

In a sleek industrial space, Eska blends creativity with comfort. Expect farm-to-table and standout baking in Prague’s coolest foodie enclave. High-end feel with reasonable prices.

This candlelit salon-style restaurant exudes romance and old-world charm. Specializing in game and duck, it’s a step back in time and a splurge-worthy way to savor Czech cuisine.

Hidden near Národní třída, Tiskárna delivers creative, upscale dining at half the expected price. With a sleek interior and rave reviews, it’s a local favorite for quality without the fuss. Book ahead.

TRADITIONAL FARE

Hostinec U Rotundy | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

Tucked near the river, this no-frills pub offers hearty Czech dishes in an old-school setting. Beloved by locals for its authenticity and affordable prices.

U Bulínů | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

Family-run with rustic charm, this cozy spot is known for generous portions and balanced flavors. A local favorite, reserve ahead for dinner.

Pivovar Bašta (U Bansethů) | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

Split between a taproom and Pilsner pub, this spot serves rich Czech fare under the Nusle Bridge. The duck is a standout, and the atmosphere is pure neighborhood beer hall.

U Veverky | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

Known as “The Squirrel,” this residential pub is a local institution. Expect traditional fare, fresh Pilsner from the tank, and a lively crowd, especially before Sparta Prague games.

Near the Vyšehrad fort, this small family-run restaurant serves elevated home-style Czech food at great value. Cozy and popular, book ahead for dinner.

SWEETS

Cukrář Skála | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

One of Prague’s top sweet spots. Skála’s pistachio ice cream is legendary.

Crème de la Crème | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

The other of Prague’s top sweet spots. Crème de la Crème serves artisanal scoops that rival any in Europe.

SCENIC DRINKS

Letná Beer Garden | [Location](#)

Beneath chestnut trees with sweeping views of Old Town and the Vltava, this laid-back beer garden is a local favorite. Grab a drink, snag a picnic table, and soak in the sunset.

Náplavka Riverbank | [Location](#)

On summer evenings, this riverside strip comes alive with DJs, food stalls, and locals sipping drinks on the embankment wall. Enjoy views of the water and Prague Castle.

Hospůdka Na Hradbách (Vyšehrad Beer Garden) | [Location](#)

Tucked atop the medieval walls of Vyšehrad, this relaxed beer garden has panoramic views over Nusle Bridge and the rooftops.

Střelecký Ostrov Stage Bar | [Location](#)

This leafy island bar offers front-row views of Charles Bridge and Prague Castle. Peaceful by day, lively with music by night, it’s a magical sunset spot right on the river.

Above Lucerna Palace, this quirky rooftop terrace is only open on select nights, so check ahead. It’s perfect for golden-hour drinks amid lights and music.
