CAFÉS & SWEET TREATS

Café Prückel | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

A classic café on Stubenring with a preserved 1950s interior and bow-tied waiters. Enjoy strudel, schnitzel, and goulash.

Café Bräunerhof | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

A 1920s literary café hidden near antique shops where you can sip a Melange while listening to live piano. Try the Sachertorte.

Café Jelinek | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

A bohemian café in Mariahilf favored by students writing papers, serving strong coffee and homemade cakes.

Café Sperl | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

Open since 1880, Café Sperl has marble tables, bentwood chairs, tall windows, and billiard tables. Enjoy a melange and Gugelhupf in true fin-de-siècle style.

Café Rüdigerhof | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

This 1904 Jugendstil-era café is loved for Buchteln, coffee, and beer, a favorite amongst the hip, artsy crowd.

TRADITIONAL AUSTRIAN

Gasthaus Pöschl | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

A local Wirtshaus serving classic Viennese dishes like schnitzel and Tafelspitz. Unpretentious, welcoming, and popular with longtime regulars.

Glacis Beisl | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

A rustic beisl near the MuseumsQuartier with a quiet garden patio. Serves classic Viennese dishes and Austrian wines without any fuss.

Wiener Wiaz Haus | [Menu](#) | [Location](#)

Family-run inn known for top-value schnitzel, hearty Austrian dishes, local beer, and a cozy vibe. Book ahead, it's a local favorite.

A tavern in Alsergrund serving honest Austrian fare like goulash and strudel. Fair prices, cold beer, and a gemütlich feel await.

SCENIC ROOFTOPS & VIEWS

A hidden gem atop the Palace of Justice with sweeping views of Vienna. Open weekdays for lunch or coffee. Affordable, tasty dishes and no crowds.

This rooftop bar sits atop Hotel Lamée with eye-level views of St. Stephen's Cathedral. Open year-round with cocktails, brunch, and stunning sunsets. Be sure to arrive early or reserve.
